


Web Accessibility Monitoring

- Monitoring methodology is based on WCAG requirements
- Combination of automated and manual verification methods



Assessment of 100 state-owned websites

Conducted annually (2021, 2022)

- Lack of alternative texts for images
 - Lack of supportive text for hyperlinks

Lack of keyboard focus indicator




